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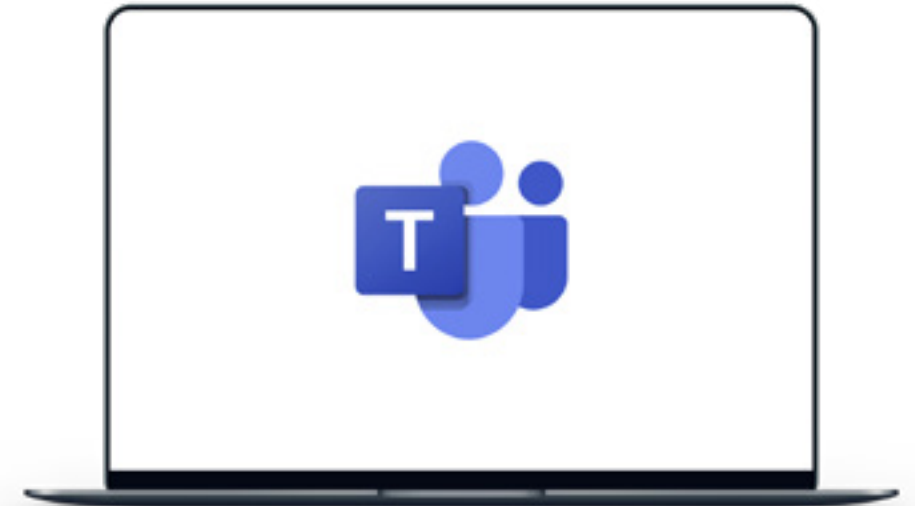


# Integrate learning content quickly and easily into the everyday life of your employees

When creating a course, also use the automatic creation of a channel in MS Teams with all course participants to strengthen the bond in virtual teams.



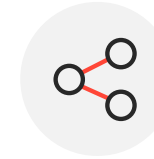
## Quick access to the LMS
