Manage your content via one single source for all applications of the ecosystem

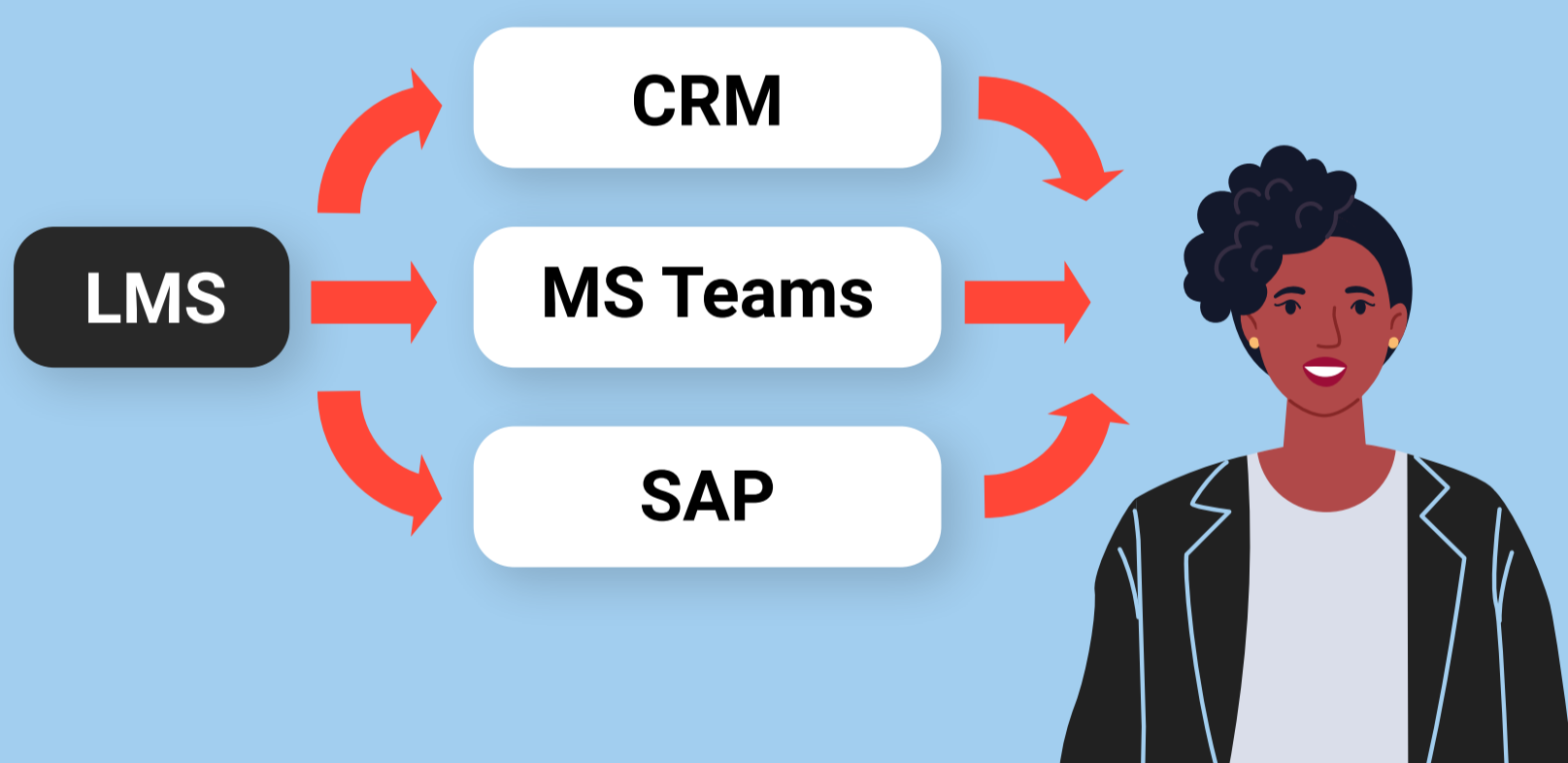
Publish contents to multiple displays

Def.: Both the headless LMS and CMS allow for content to not only be published to a website or primary platform, but also across a range of channels. The system does not have a single presentation layer – as it is ‘headless’, it is a content repository with a powerful administration interface to support content management and creation.¹

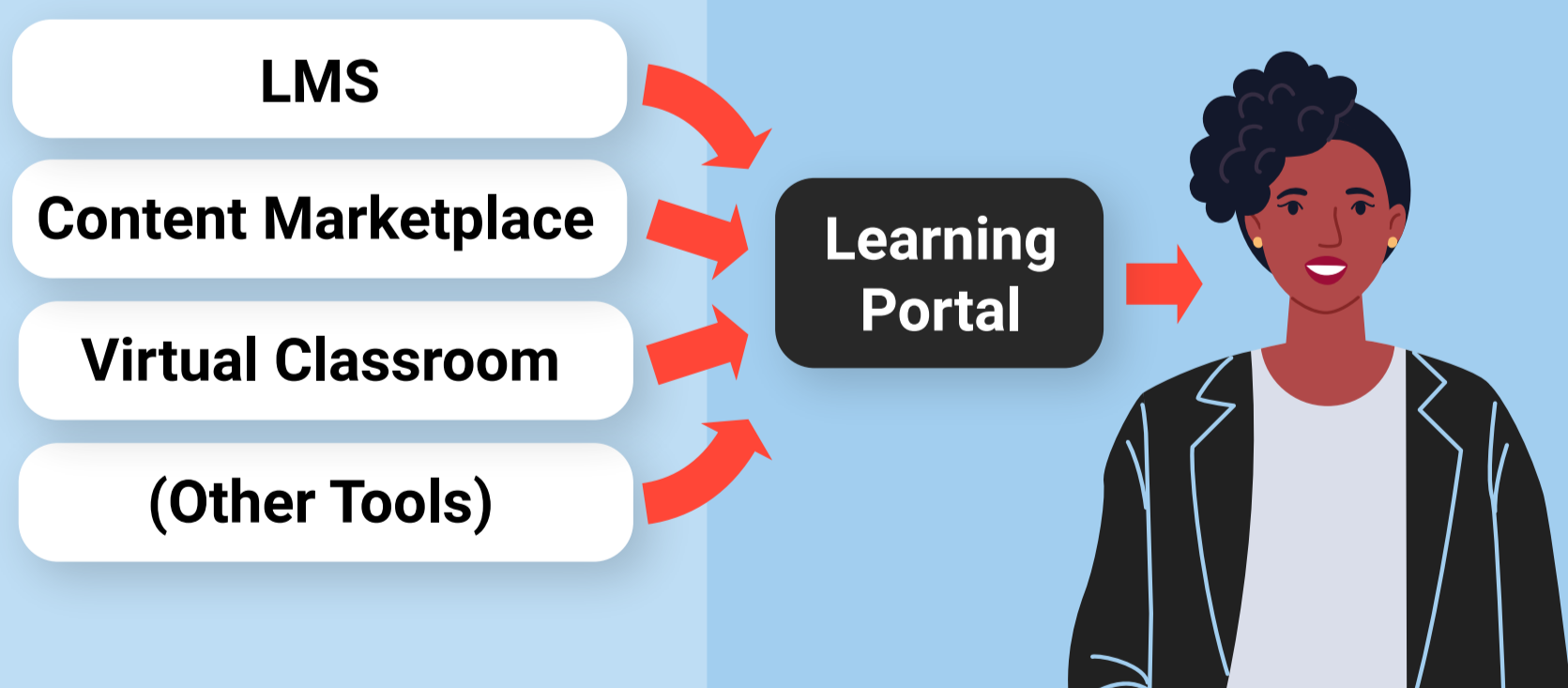


Scenario 1
